PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES

Registration:

• Participants need to register themselves before the deadline mentioned on the official website or communication channels.



Eligibility:

- To be eligible for participation, individuals must be registered online.
- All participants must carry valid identification proof.

Guidelines:

- Participants must complete their artwork within the allotted time during the competition.
- The participants name, registration no. should be mentioned on the back side of the sheet.
- Any form of misconduct, such as tampering with others' work or using prohibited materials will result in automatic disqualification.
- Entries submitted after the deadline will not be acceptable.
- The organizers reserve the right to photograph or display the submitted artwork.
- Only A3 drawing sheets will be provided by the organisers. Rest requirements should be made by the participants themselves.
- Use of Laptops is strictly prohibited.

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- Participants will be responsible for their own belongings and equipment. Organizers will not be liable for any loss or damage.
- All submissions (audio/video/photo) must meet the specified time limits and criteria. Failure to comply will result in disqualification.
- Participants must report on time. Any delay will result in point deductions, and in extreme cases, repeated delays may lead to disqualification.
- Any form of vulgar, abusive, or offensive language or actions will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Participants must maintain proper discipline throughout the event. Any disrespect or misbehavior towards organizers or other participants will result in disqualification.
- Participants must follow all event-specific rules and regulations. Deviation from the rules may lead to disqualification.
- Any actions that jeopardize the safety or well-being of others, or are deemed inappropriate by the organizers, will lead to disqualification.

JUDGING CRITERIA

The following parameters will be used to evaluate the submissions:

1. Theme Relevance: Adherence to the theme provided.



- 2. Creativity and Originality: The uniqueness of the concept and execution.
- 3. Overall Presentation: Composition, color harmony and visual impact.

Prize Pool: 6K
