PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES

Registration:

- Participants need to register themselves before the deadline mentioned on the official website or communication channels.

Eligibility:

- To be eligible for participation, individuals must be registered online.
 - All participants must carry valid identification proof.

 - Fictional characters (movies, animes, cartoons etc)
 - Self customized dresses

Guidelines:

- Costumes should adhere to decency and appropriateness for a college fest environment.
 - Participants must arrive 30 minutes before the event for costume check and lineup.
 - Contestants are responsible for their own costumes and props.
 - Participants must stay in character throughout their performance for the best effect.

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- Participants will be responsible for their own belongings and equipment. Organizers will not be liable for any loss or damage.
 - All submissions (audio/video/photo) must meet the specified time limits and criteria. Failure to comply will result in disqualification.
 - Participants must report on time. Any delay will result in point deductions, and in extreme cases, repeated delays may lead to disqualification.
 - Any form of vulgar, abusive, or offensive language or actions will lead to immediate disqualification.
 - Participants must maintain proper discipline throughout the event. Any disrespect or misbehavior towards organizers or other participants will result in disqualification.
 - Participants must follow all event-specific rules and regulations. Deviation from the rules may lead to disqualification.
 - Any actions that jeopardize the safety or well-being of others, or are deemed inappropriate by the organizers, will lead to disqualification.

 3. Props are allowed but should not pose any safety hazard.
 4. Inappropriate content or offensive costumes will lead to disqualification.
