Open to individual participants registered online.









\Registration Guidelines:

• Registration Process:

- Participants must register online, providing the following details:
 - Name
 - Contact details
 - Department
 - Dance style
 - Song choice

• Performance Duration:

- Performances should not exceed the time limit of 2-3 minutes for the Qualifying round.
- Performances should not exceed the time limit of 4-5 minutes for Finale.

• Dance Style:

o Participants can choose any dance style.

• Props and Costumes:

• Props and costumes are allowed but must be arranged by the participant.

• Music Submission:

• Music files must be submitted in mp3 format in advance.

• Stage Conduct:

o No inappropriate gestures or lyrics in music will be tolerated.

• Disqualification Criteria:

• Late arrivals, violation of guidelines, or use of prohibited props will result in disqualification.

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- Participants will be responsible for their own belongings and equipment. Organizers will
 not be liable for any loss or damage.
- All submissions (audio/video/photo) must meet the specified time limits and criteria. Failure to comply will result in disqualification.
- Participants must report on time. Any delay will result in point deductions, and in extreme cases, repeated delays may lead to disqualification.
- Any form of vulgar, abusive, or offensive language or actions will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Participants must maintain proper discipline throughout the event. Any disrespect or misbehavior towards organizers or other participants will result in disqualification.









• Participants must follow all event-specific rules and regulations. Deviation from the rules may lead to disqualification.

Any actions that jeopardize the safety or well-being of others, or are deemed inappropriate by the organizers, will lead to disqualification.
