## • Eligibility:

o Open to individual participants registered online.









# **Registration Guidelines:**

## Registration Process:

- The group must register online, providing necessary details:
  - Team name
  - Captain's contact information
  - Team members: Not exceed more than 10 members
  - Dance style
  - Song choice

## Participation Fee:

o A small fee may be charged to cover event costs and ensure team commitment .

#### • Performance Duration:

- Performances should not exceed the time limit of 3-4 minutes for the Qualifying round.
- Performances should not exceed the time limit of 6-8 minutes for Finale.

### • Dance Style:

 Participants can choose from any dance style (e.g., Bollywood, Hip-hop, Classical, Contemporary).

### • Props and Costumes:

• Props and costumes are allowed but must be managed by the team itself. Ensure quick setup and cleanup.

### • Music Submission:

- Music files must be submitted in mp3 format in advance.
- o Format: Team name

## • Stage Conduct:

• No inappropriate gestures or lyrics in music will be tolerated.

# • Disqualification Criteria:

 Late arrivals, violation of guidelines, or unsafe behavior may lead to disqualification.

# **Judging Parameters:**

# 1. Choreography & Creativity

Creativity, use of space, and original dance moves.









### 2. Synchronization:

• Coordination and timing within the team.

## 3. Stage Presence & Energy:

o Confidence, expression, and engagement with the audience.

## 4. Technique:

• Skill level, smooth execution, and complexity of moves.

### 5. Costume & Presentation:

• Effort in costume and overall visual impact.

#### **GENERAL GUIDELINES:**

- Participants will be responsible for their own belongings and equipment. Organizers will
  not be liable for any loss or damage.
- All submissions (audio/video/photo) must meet the specified time limits and criteria. Failure to comply will result in disqualification.
- Participants must report on time. Any delay will result in point deductions, and in extreme cases, repeated delays may lead to disqualification.
- Any form of vulgar, abusive, or offensive language or actions will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Participants must maintain proper discipline throughout the event. Any disrespect or misbehavior towards organizers or other participants will result in disqualification.
- Participants must follow all event-specific rules and regulations. Deviation from the rules may lead to disqualification.

Any actions that jeopardize the safety or well-being of others, or are deemed inappropriate by the organizers, will lead to disqualification.
