Description:

• This event invites aspiring actors and playwrights to showcase their creativity. Rangmanch is not just a competition, it's a platform for artistic expression that highlights the power of storytelling.

GUIDELINES

Registration:

- Participants need to register their teams before the deadline mentioned on the official website or communication channels.
- Participants are required to confirm their characters during registration to avoid duplication.

Eligibility:

- To be eligible for participation, individuals must be registered online.
- All participants must carry valid identification proof.

Guidelines:

- All teams must comprise a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 10 members.
- The time duration of act will be from 5 15 minutes
- Crossing the limit will lead to a reduction in 5 points and no disqualification.



GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- Participants will be responsible for their own belongings and equipment. Organizers will not be liable for any loss or damage.
- All submissions (audio/video/photo) must meet the specified time limits and criteria. Failure to comply will result in disqualification.
- Participants must report on time. Any delay will result in point deductions, and in extreme cases, repeated delays may lead to disqualification.
- Any form of vulgar, abusive, or offensive language or actions will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Participants must maintain proper discipline throughout the event. Any disrespect or misbehavior towards organizers or other participants will result in disqualification.
- Participants must follow all event-specific rules and regulations. Deviation from the rules may lead to disqualification.

Any actions that jeopardize the safety or well-being of others, or are deemed inappropriate by the organizers, will lead to disqualification.

JUDGING CRITERIA

The following parameters will be used to evaluate the submissions:

- 1. Acting power of individual members (gestures and voice modulation)
- 2. Group coordination.
- 3. Creativity & originality of the script.
- 4. Creative actions and props.
- 5. Value and strength of message shared.

EVENT RULES.

- 1. Props are allowed but should not pose any safety hazard.
- 2. Participants must follow the time limit of 5-15 minutes on stage.
- 3. Inappropriate content or offensive language will lead to disqualification.
- 4. The play can be in any medium (language).
- 5. The genre of the play is open to the teams preference.
