## **PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES**

### **Registration:**

- Teams need to register themselves before the deadline mentioned on the official website or communication channels.
  - Participants should provide the names, contact details, and roles of all team members during registration.
- 

### **Eligibility:**

- The competition is open to all college/university students.
- Each team must consist of a maximum of **4 members**.
- Participants must abide by all guidelines and safety regulations outlined below.

## Guidelines:

### Submission :

**Time:** 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM

**Format:** Team Name & Registration no.

### Team Formation:

- Each team should have 2–4 members. Collaboration and teamwork will be key in building your project.

### Materials:

- **Allowed Materials:**  
Teams must use a minimum of 60% scrap materials in their project construction.
- **Prohibited Materials:**  
Hazardous materials such as sharp objects, unshielded glass, and live electrical components without proper insulation are strictly prohibited to ensure safety.

### Project Type:

- Teams may create any functional or artistic project that aligns with the competition's sustainability theme.
- **Weight Limit:** Projects must not exceed 5 kg in total weight.

### Tool Usage:

- Teams may use any tools necessary for crafting their project. However, safety precautions must be followed at all times.

### Project Creation:

- All construction must be completed at home or designated team spaces. Teams must document the process through photos and videos for transparency.
- Final projects must be presented at NIT Uttarakhand during the event.

---

## JUDGING CRITERIA

Projects will be evaluated based on the following parameters:

### 1. Functionality

How well the project performs its intended function or purpose.

2. **Aesthetic Appeal**

The creativity, design, and visual impact of the project.

3. **Innovative Use of Scrap Materials**

The degree to which scrap materials are creatively utilized.

4. **Presentation**

Clarity, communication, and explanation of the design process during the final presentation.

---

## GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- Participants will be responsible for their own belongings and equipment. Organizers will not be liable for any loss or damage.
- All submissions (audio/video/photo) must meet the specified time limits and criteria. Failure to comply will result in disqualification.
- Participants must report on time. Any delay will result in point deductions, and in extreme cases, repeated delays may lead to disqualification.
- Any form of vulgar, abusive, or offensive language or actions will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Participants must maintain proper discipline throughout the event. Any disrespect or misbehavior towards organizers or other participants will result in disqualification.
- Participants must follow all event-specific rules and regulations. Deviation from the rules may lead to disqualification.

Any actions that jeopardize the safety or well-being of others, or are deemed inappropriate by the organizers, will lead to disqualification.

## EVENT RULES

- All participants must abide by competition safety standards.
- Teams must ensure their project aligns with sustainability and avoids hazardous materials.
- Projects must be original and adhere to the required weight and material constraints.
- Teams must present photos/videos documenting the building process.
- Judges' decisions will be final and binding.



### AN IMPORTANT NOTE:

- The organizers reserve the right to modify the rules or guidelines at any time. Any such changes will be communicated to the participants promptly.
  - Decisions made by the judging panel will be final and binding on all teams. No appeals or queries regarding the judgment will be entertained.
  - Prize pool is subjected to the number of participants and on the discretion of the organising committee.
  - Teams are responsible for ensuring their submission complies with the guidelines.
  - **Cliffesto'25** reserves the right to disqualify any team at any stage for non-compliance with the rules or misconduct.
