## Description

This event brings together exceptional vocalists who have dedicated time and effort to perfect their craft. Whether a novice or an experienced performer, each contestant has prepared to showcase their unique voice and musical interpretation, offering a diverse range of genres, styles, and emotions.

## Prize Pool: 10K

## **Guidelines:**

- Eligibility: To be eligible for participation, individuals must be registered online.
- **Registration:** Individual must register online, providing necessary details.
- **Duration:** Each song duration must not exceed 3 minutes for qualifying round and 5 minutes for finale round. For every minute exceeding the time limits, 2 points will be deducted from their total score.





- **Content and Standards:** Lyrics should not contain any obscene or offensive words. Any disrespectful behavior or any damage to the venue will result in automatic disqualification.
- Karaoke: Music file must be uploaded on google form under team name.

# **GENERAL GUIDELINES:**

- Participants will be responsible for their own belongings and equipment. Organizers will not be liable for any loss or damage.
- All submissions (audio/video/photo) must meet the specified time limits and criteria. Failure to comply will result in disqualification.
- Participants must report on time. Any delay will result in point deductions, and in extreme cases, repeated delays may lead to disqualification.
- Any form of vulgar, abusive, or offensive language or actions will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Participants must maintain proper discipline throughout the event. Any disrespect or misbehavior towards organizers or other participants will result in disqualification.
- Participants must follow all event-specific rules and regulations. Deviation from the rules may lead to disqualification.

Any actions that jeopardize the safety or well-being of others, or are deemed inappropriate by the organizers, will lead to disqualification.

# **Judging Parameters:**

Each team can achieve a maximum score of 50 points. The final scores will be determined by calculating the average of each judge's score across the following criteria:

- 1. Vocal Technique
- 2. Performance & Expression
- 3. Vocal Artistry & Interpretation
- 4. Overall Impact
- 5. Technical Execution

## Total Score: (50 Points)

In the spirit of fair play, the judge's ruling will be the final and undisputed outcome.
