- **Timings:** 08:00 AM - 01:00 PM
- **Venue:** Auditorium

### Description:

This event is looking for duets that thrive on teamwork, who embrace the spirit of music as a unifying force. If you're ready to face the challenge, connect with your audience, and create a musical masterpiece that resonates beyond the stage, it's time to step up and showcase your talent!

### Prize Pool: 16k

---

### Eligibility:

To be eligible for participation, individuals must be registered online.

### Guidelines:

- **Registration:** The duet must register itself online, providing all the necessary details.
- **Team Composition:** Each team will consist of 2 members. All members must be registered in advance.
- **Duration:**
  - For Qualifying Round: Each performance should not exceed a time limit of 3 minutes.
  - For Finale: Each performance should not exceed a time limit of 5 minutes.

- **Content and Standards:** Lyrics should not contain any obscene or offensive words. Any disrespectful behavior or any damage to the venue will result in automatic disqualification.
- Performers must bring their own instruments and accessories required for their performance.

### Additional Info:

- In total 3 microphones will be provided by the organizing committee.
- There is no limit to the number of performers who wish to participate.
- A performer can perform in both solo and duet.
- If a duet intends to perform with karaoke, they must submit their audio track in advance through online submission.

---

### GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- Participants will be responsible for their own belongings and equipment. Organizers will not be liable for any loss or damage.
- All submissions (audio/video/photo) must meet the specified time limits and criteria. Failure to comply will result in disqualification.
- Participants must report on time. Any delay will result in point deductions, and in extreme cases, repeated delays may lead to disqualification.
- Any form of vulgar, abusive, or offensive language or actions will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Participants must maintain proper discipline throughout the event. Any disrespect or misbehavior towards organizers or other participants will result in disqualification.
- Participants must follow all event-specific rules and regulations. Deviation from the rules may lead to disqualification.
- Any actions that jeopardize the safety or well-being of others, or are deemed inappropriate by the organizers, will lead to disqualification.

### Judging Parameters:

The final scores will be determined by calculating the average of each judge's score across the following criteria:

1. Overall Stage Performance
2. Uniqueness
3. Quality
4. Synchronization
5. Audience Engagement



In the spirit of fair play, the judge's ruling will be the final and undisputed outcome.

- The organizers reserve the right to modify the rules or guidelines at any time. Any such changes will be communicated to the participants promptly.
  - Decisions made by the judging panel will be final and binding on all teams. No appeals or queries regarding the judgment will be entertained.

  - Teams are responsible for ensuring their submission complies with the guidelines.
