- This is a **development competition** where participants are required to solve realworld engineering problems, create innovative designs, and showcase your expertise in CAD tools like SolidWorks, Autodesk Fusion 360, etc.
- The problems will be provided at the start of the event.
- Prize Pool for the competition: ₹23000 *.
- The registration limit is 50 participants, the participant registration will be on a first come first serve basis.

PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES

Team Specifications:

- Individual participation.
- Participants can be from the same or different institutes.

Registration:



- Participants need to register themselves before the deadline mentioned on the official website or communication channels.
- Each participant must provide valid contact details of themselves.

Eligibility:

- The DraftDuel is open to all students and professionals.
- All participants must carry valid identification proof.

DraftDuel FORMAT

Problem Statement:

- The problem statement will be disclosed at the start of the event.
- Teams are expected to develop a solution adhering to the problem statement's requirements and constraints.

Development Guidelines:

- Participants are required to be present 30 minutes earlier before the competition.
- Use of unfair means is not allowed.
- Every participant must have their own laptop during the competition.
- Participants may bring their own extension cords.
- Participants are not allowed to connect their laptops to the internet during the competition, except in the last 10 minutes for submission.
- Cell phones are not allowed during the competition.
- Students must bring their own calculators, papers, and pens for calculations.
- Participants are requested to verify the working of required software prior to the start of competition.

Submission details:

- Participants must submit their work by emailing it to <u>techclub@nituk.ac.in</u> and <u>cliffesto@nituk.ac.in</u>. All other submission methods will be considered invalid.
- Participants must be present at the decided venue for their submissions to be considered.



EVENT RULES

- Participants can use any CAD software (e.g., Solidworks, Fusion360, etc.).
- Violation of the above-mentioned rules may lead to disqualification.
- The organizers have the right to disqualify participants on valid grounds. The organizers' decisions are final and binding

PRIZE AND CERTIFICATES

- Prize Money: Prize money will be awarded after the final round, processed through NEFT.
- E-Certificates: E-certificates will be awarded to participants scoring above a minimum cutoff, which will be announced later.
- Prize pool for this event is: 23,000*/-

CERTIFICATE POLICY:

• E-certificates will be awarded to teams that meet the minimum score requirement (cutoff to be announced later).
